The works associated with Hawaiian's Park Centre Upgrade located on Albany Highway Victoria Park comprised of the demolition of existing external concrete paving in order for the realignment of barrier kerbing to make way for new washed exposed aggregate paving, the construction of three new entry statements, timber planter boxes and bench seating to suit Hawaiian's branding.

Works were carried out within a live operating shopping centre environment where access to almost every tenancy directly impacted by the upgrade works, is restricted to one external entry and egress for both patrons and staff alike.

The new signage pylon, landscaping and irrigation works were coordinated to suit the staging of car park resurfacing works within a facility already under pressure to accommodate parking for patrons on a daily basis.

In addition, the refurbishment of the existing service corridor, male and female amenities were undertaken within the tight project timeframe.
